Panorama and Pivot controls are simple ways to have interaction

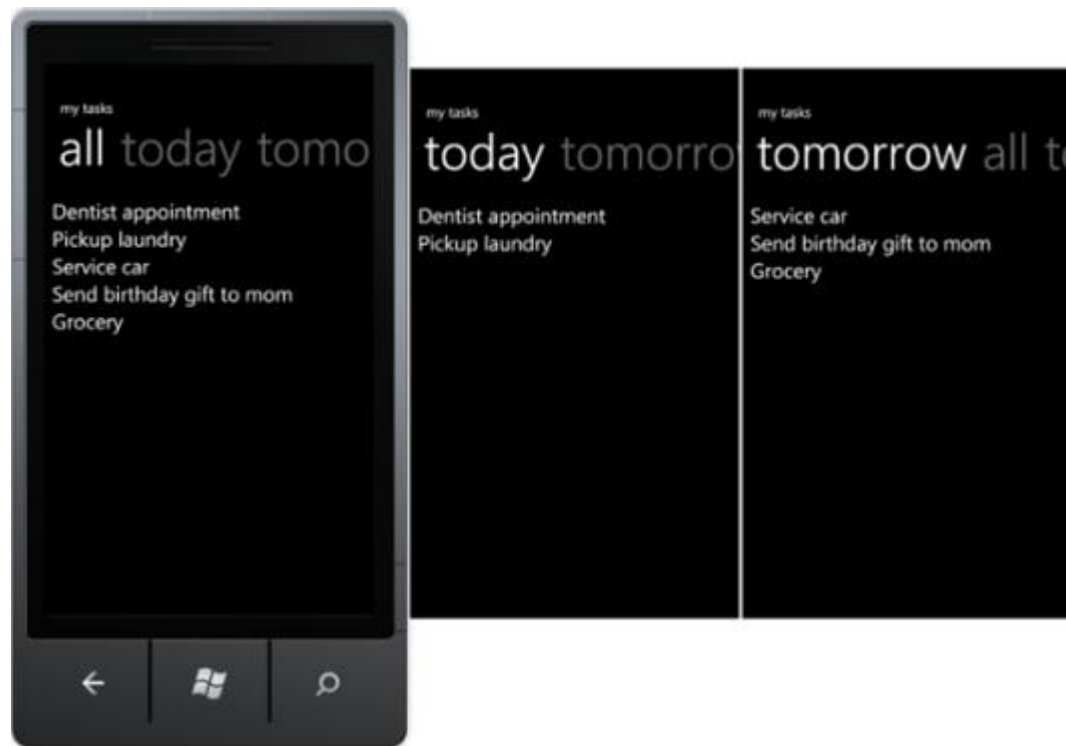
Panorama Control

What we did:

- Added Pivot control with multiple items which will later be filled with more content

Interactivity

What else you could do?

-Data drill-down on separate page



Feedback

You should display good feedback to the user so they know what's going on.

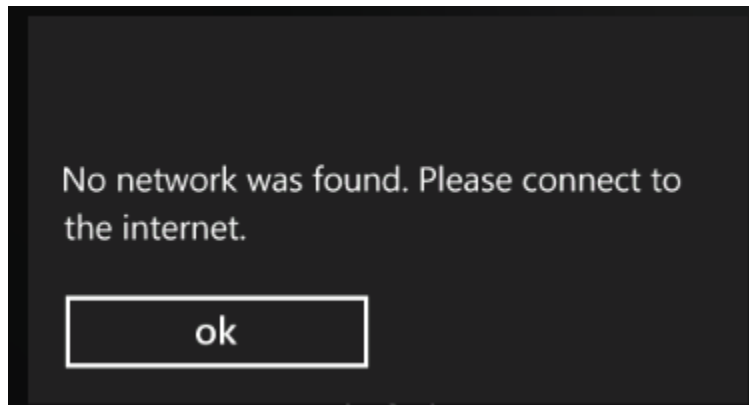
This yields a good UX.

Considerations

- No network connection
- Lag time while app is working

Message boxes and progress indicators



Feedback

What we did:

- Added MessageBox to alert user of no network
- Added C1ProgressBar to show the app is working

Functionality

Give the user more than one way to view the data

- Grouped/summarized
- Data visualization (charts, gauges, heat maps, etc)

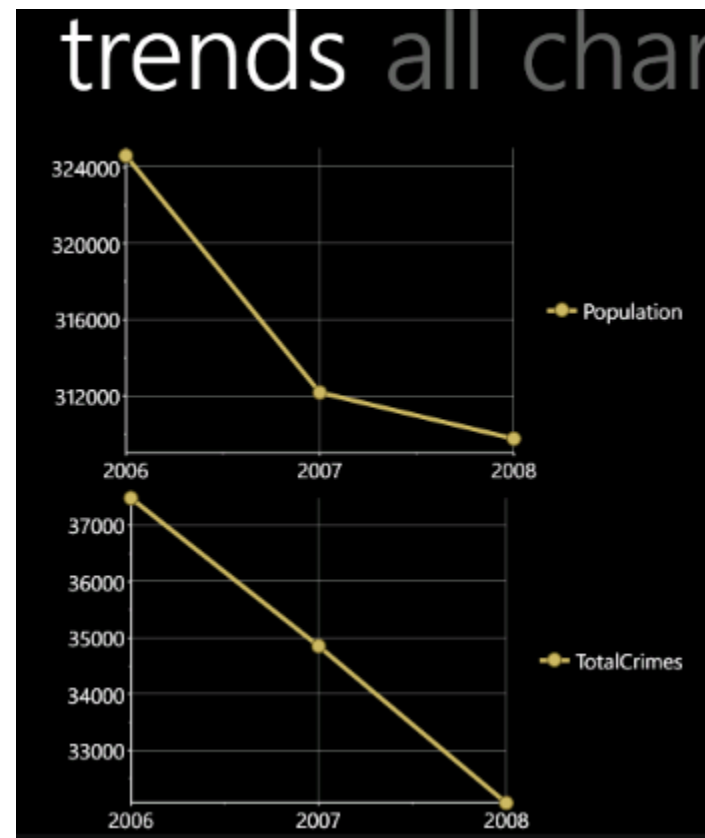
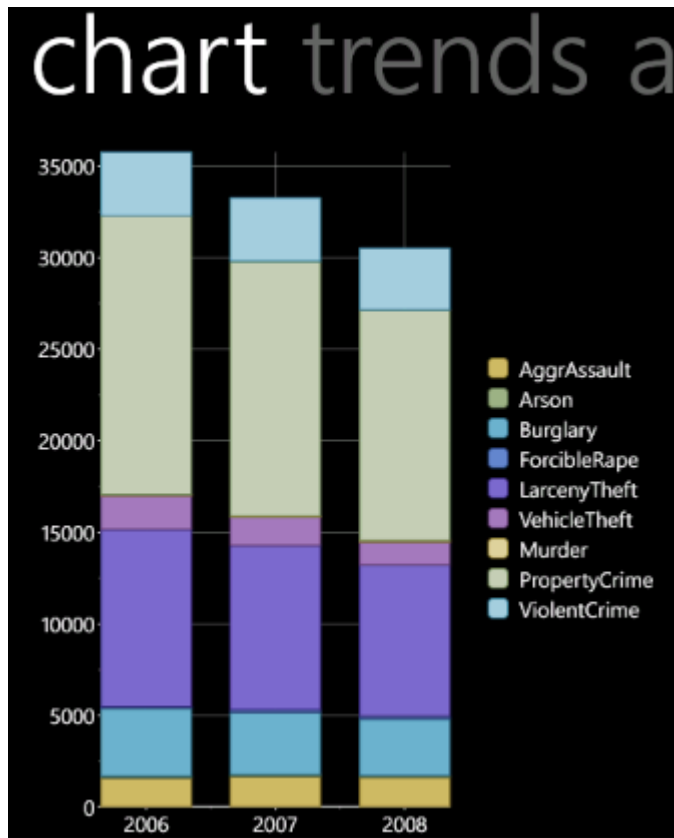
C1Chart

- 30 chart types
- Legend
- Zoom interaction
- Panning
- Data labels
- Stackable plot areas
- Multiple axes
- Color palettes

Functionality

What we did:

- Added two charts for better data visualization
- Added context menu for more chart functionality

Functionality

What else you could do?

- Give user option to change the city/state
 - Input field
 - Interactive Map control
- Determine user's location using the Windows Phone location services (GPS)

Tile Title

Tile Background Image

-Used if user pins your app to their start page
